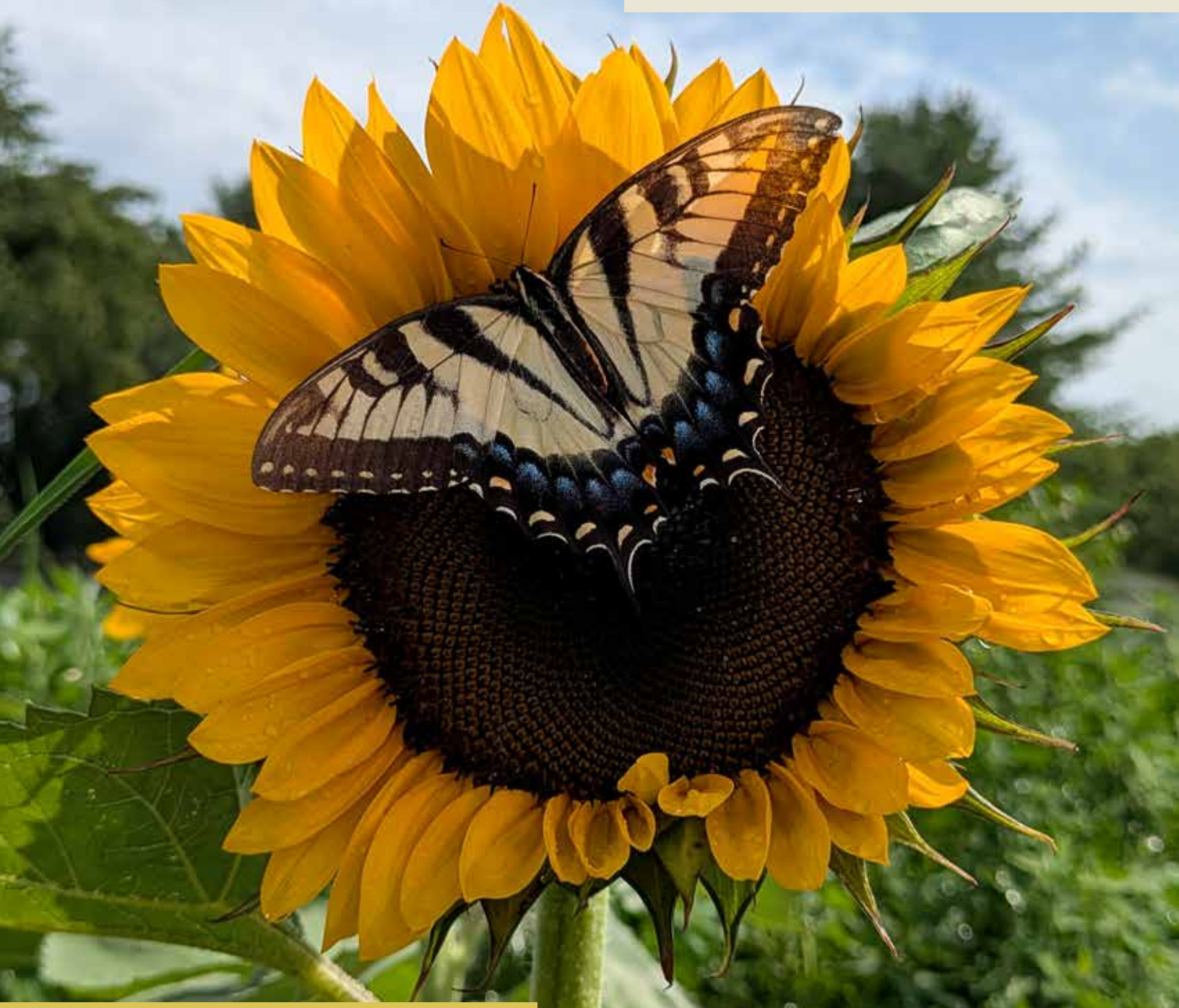

## Winged Wonders: The Eastern Tiger Swallowtail

The Eastern Tiger Swallowtail Butterfly gracing our cover is renowned for its impressive size and striking yellow and black striped wings. First emerging in April and May, Tiger Swallowtails are often the first large, showy butterflies that are seen each spring, bringing splashes of color to our landscapes. The caterpillars of this species are just as intriguing! When the caterpillar first hatches, it is small, dark, and blotchy. Its brown, black, and white coloring makes it closely resemble bird droppings. As this caterpillar grows, it turns bright green and develops large eye spots that mimic the face of a small snake. This visual trick can startle birds and discourage attacks. We extend our gratitude to local resident Brittany Hirschfeld for capturing and sharing this beautiful image with us!

## Brookview Bird Survey

This is an amazing opportunity to get some real-world research experience while learning about our native birds! ## Fundamentals of Fungi
