The Park District was recently awarded a grant through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources' NatureWorks program for accessibility improvements at Petrikis Park! These grant funds are being utilized to add a shade sail to the current playground and to upgrade connectivity throughout the park. We will be adding nature-inspired musical equipment along an accessible path, providing barrier-free access from the parking lot to all the park's features, including the existing pickleball courts and the pollinator garden! 
