The Park District was recently awarded a grant through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources' NatureWorks program for accessibility improvements at Petrikis Park! These grant funds are being utilized to add a shade sail to the current playground and to upgrade connectivity throughout the park. We will be adding nature-inspired musical equipment along an accessible path, providing barrier-free access from the parking lot to all the park's features, including the existing pickleball courts and the pollinator garden! We are excited to bring these new features to the community to continue to promote inclusiveness for persons of all ages and abilities!

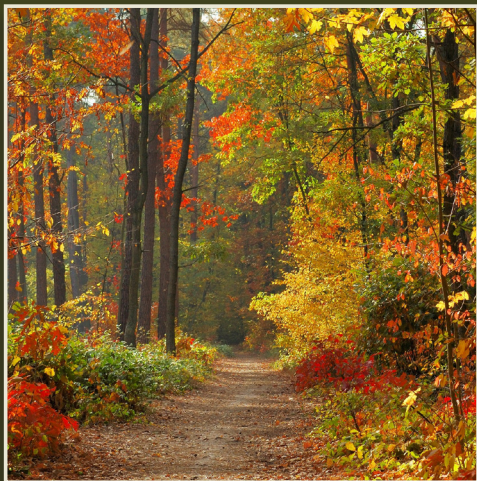

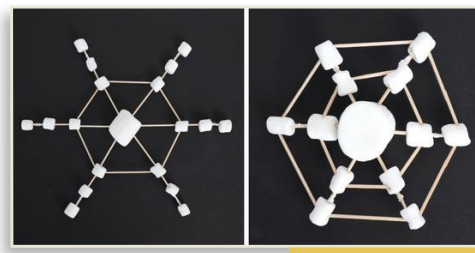

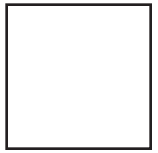
