

## Minutes Regular Meeting Bellbrook-Sugarcreek Park District July 24, 2025

# **CALL TO ORDER**

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners of the Bellbrook-Sugarcreek Park District, also known as the Bellbrook-Sugarcreek Park District, was held at the Park Headquarters. # **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

## Approval of New Expenses

### **Bieser Reserve Construction Contract**

Mr. Haller moved, Dr. Krance seconded, and the Commission approved a motion to award the Bieser Reserve Access Improvement Contract to Majors Enterprises Inc for the bid amount of \$332,315.00. Total approved amount is not to exceed the original Engineers Estimate of \$347,121.00.

- Conditional approval sought for the potential hiring of a part-time maintenance position.
