Regulations for Metal Detecting within Bellbrook Sugarcreek Park District

- 1. The applicant listed above is solely responsible and liable for all damages to wildlife, park grounds, facilities and other park property resulting from permit holder's use. Any charges incurred will be billed directly to the individual.
- 2. The applicant while using this permit must comply with all Bellbrook City and Sugarcreek Township ordinances, park rules and regulations of the Bellbrook Sugarcreek Park District (copies available on website or at request), State of Ohio laws and United States Government.
- **3.** Use of metal detectors is prohibited in restricted areas of the parks and preservation areas. It is also prohibited in areas including plant beds, gardens, tree bases, unmowed vegetation, game and practice space of athletic fields.
- 4. Tools used for probing must be similar to a digging trowel, with a blade length of no more than 7" and 2" width.
- 5. Any area disturbed must be returned to its "natural" state as found prior to the permit holder's activities.
- 6. Permit holders must avoid areas where activities are scheduled or are taking place, i.e. family gatherings reserved through the park district, park-sponsored events and athletic league use.
- 7. Permit expires within one calendar year from date issued.
- 8. This permit is non-transferrable and must be in your possession while using the metal detector.
- **9.** All items of value found in the parks must be inspected by a park supervisor at: 2751 Washington Mill Road, Bellbrook, Ohio.
- 10. Violation of any of the above will result in your contract being terminated and permit being revoked.
- 11. A fee of \$50 for non-residents will be assessed when this application is received, it is not refundable once the application has been approved under any circumstance. There is no permit charge for City of Bellbrook or Sugarcreek Township residents.

IMPORTANT FACTS TO REMEMBER:

- 1. Alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted in the Parks
- 2. ALL Parks close at dark
- 3. Person applying for this permit must be 21 years of age or older
- 4. Parking is limited to designated parking areas ONLY
- 5. Charge for yearly permit and permit application must be submitted at the same time.
