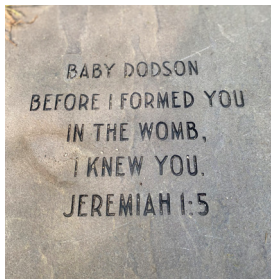
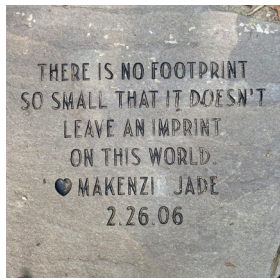


A few of our children's stones...

The loss of a child is often referred to as the ultimate tragedy. Bereaved parents, grandparents, siblings, etc. mourn the death of a child of any age ... it feels unnatural to outlive a child. The loss of a child instrumentally changes the entire family. However, the bond might be changed but it's never broken.



Remembrance Ridge is nestled in a quiet corner of Magee Park and includes a backdrop of tall, beautiful trees and a trickling creek. A perfect, quiet place for reflection.

The Remembrance Ridge stones serve as a special memorial and are custom engraved to honor a loved one with your personalized message. If you would like to have a stone engraved to honor a child who is no longer with us, please contact us (our contact info is on the back). We have engraving sessions once or twice a year.

There is also a fund to help anyone who wants a stone, but lack finances, to have one engraved. (The Remembrance Ridge Committee accepts donations if you would like to assist another family purchase their stone.)
