Commissioner Retirement

The Bellbrook Sugarcreek Park District would like to thank Randy Tischer for his twenty-one-year tenure as a Park Board Commissioner! Randy's service to the parks began in 2003, but his roots within the community date back to the 1950's when his family purchased a local farm within the Township. Improving Our Spaces

In late 2023, the park district applied for and was awarded a grant through the Greene County Council on Aging to improve our indoor programming space. With the funds awarded, a high-quality room divider was installed to allow us to best utilize the space for community and senior programs. The divider not only provides for easy program set up and transition, but also improves the sound quality throughout the room. Creepy, Crawly Caterpillar Cutie

You may be surprised to learn that the caterpillar on the front cover is the larval stage of one of our most beloved insects: the Monarch Butterfly! This little guy is easily recognizable thanks to its distinctive black, white, and yellow stripes.

They have hearty appetites and can devour up to 200 times their body weight in milkweed leaves during their growth. This specialized diet provides them with the necessary toxic chemicals to defend against predators. Keep your eyes open to spot this cutie chomping away in the parks this spring!




